## **OBJECTIVES**

The Urban Transformation Agenda for Sustainable Development (ATUSS) is an investment program under the ERDF PR Emilia-Romagna 2021-2027 involving14 urban areas and territorial systems, and in which the municipality of Cesena together with the municipalities of Mercato Saraceno, Sarsina and Montiano are involved.

The objective of the ATUSS "CESENA 2030" is to contribute to the pursuit of sustainable urban development in order to increase the attractiveness of the territories, promote the ecological transition, but above all to enable the creation of new places for sociality and participation. In this context, the priority area of ATUSS is to create and redevelop spaces for sports, wellness and sociality.


## **ACTIVITIES**

In particular, the interventions of the ATUSS "CESENA 2030" are:

- 1) Cesena Sport City: construction of the new municipal swimming pool in the municipality of Cesena with an ERDF contribution of €6.300.000.00:
- 2) Sarsina: regeneration of the "A.Versari" sports center with an ERDF contribution of 350,000.00 €;
- **3) Mercato Saraceno**: urban redevelopment of the historic center of Monte Castello with an ERDF contribution of 350,000.00 €:

- **4) Montiano:** construction of a bicycle/pedestrian path between the municipality of Montiano and the hamlet of Montenovo with an ERDF contribution of €350,000.00;
- 5) Cesena: OpenLab: digital meets suburbs with an ERDF contribution of €350,000.00; 6) Cesena: Integrated Educating Community: the City becomes School with an ESF+ contribution of €700,000.00.

In particular, within the macro-project Cesena Sport City, the administration intends to build the new municipal swimming pool through the construction of the new volume and subsequent demolition of the existing building, in order to increase the energy and structural efficiency of the municipal building stock, ensuring the continuity of function of the indoor pools and with a reduced land consumption intervention. The goal of the project is to build a new sports center dedicated to the sport of swimming at the site of the current pool dating back to 1972. The new facility will be adjacent to a neighborhood square and green area and will be equipped with three indoor pools. The water surface area of the planned indoor pools will be increased by 60 percent compared to the current building. In addition to its function as a swimming center, the new building will feature complementary activities such as a bar on the ground floor serving the indoor and outdoor pools, shop point, administrative offices, a grandstand for the public, and a gymnasium on the first floor also serving as a musclebuilding space.
