What is it

The Green City Accord is a network of European cities committed to the protection and enhancement of the environment in urban areas.

The Green City Accord aims to raise the quality of life of all inhabitants and to speed up the implementation of EU environmental laws.

By signing the Agreement, cities are committed to setting specific goals for 2030 and develop projects in **5 areas**: air, water, nature and biodiversity, circular economy and noise.

Objectives

- Improve **air quality** in cities by complying with the World Health Organization (WHO)
- Improve the **quality of water resources** and optimize their use
- Enhance urban **green areas** and restore **urban ecosystems**
- Developing services for a **circular economy** by improving the management of urban waste and reuse, repair and recycling activities
- Reduction of **noise pollution** following the levels recommended by the WHO.
