- □ Increasing the **employability** of third-country nationals, particularly youths and women;
- □ Contributing to existing **knowledge** on the problem of over-qualification at EU level;
- □ Empowering young migrants and women, particularly new comers to have a better **access** to the labour market;
- □ Contributing to the Common European modules for migrant integration;
- Contributing to the implementation at local level of the EU 2020 agenda for smart, sustainable and inclusive growth.
