In so doing, the project will have the following specific objectives:

- ❑ Addressing the **mismatch** between skilled third-country nationals and their jobs and their under-capitalisation;
- ❑ Raising **awareness** of the importance of utilising skilled migrants for boosting economic growth and prosperity;
- ❑ Transferring and capitalizing on initiatives built elsewhere in order to build common and flexible **tools** for diagnosing the over-qualification problem and providing solutions that can be transferable in all EU member states;
- ❑ Promoting an integrated and sustainable approach to addressing the barriers of skilled third-country nationals by **involving** key stakeholders and qualified third-country nationals in the diagnosis and design of solutions;
- ❑ Increasing the **employability** of third-country nationals, particularly youths and women;
- ❑ Contributing to existing **knowledge** on the problem of over-qualification at EU level;
- ❑ Empowering young migrants and women, particularly new comers to have a better **access** to the labour market;
- ❑ Contributing to the Common European modules for migrant integration;
- ❑ Contributing to the implementation at local level of the **EU 2020** agenda for smart, sustainable and inclusive growth.
